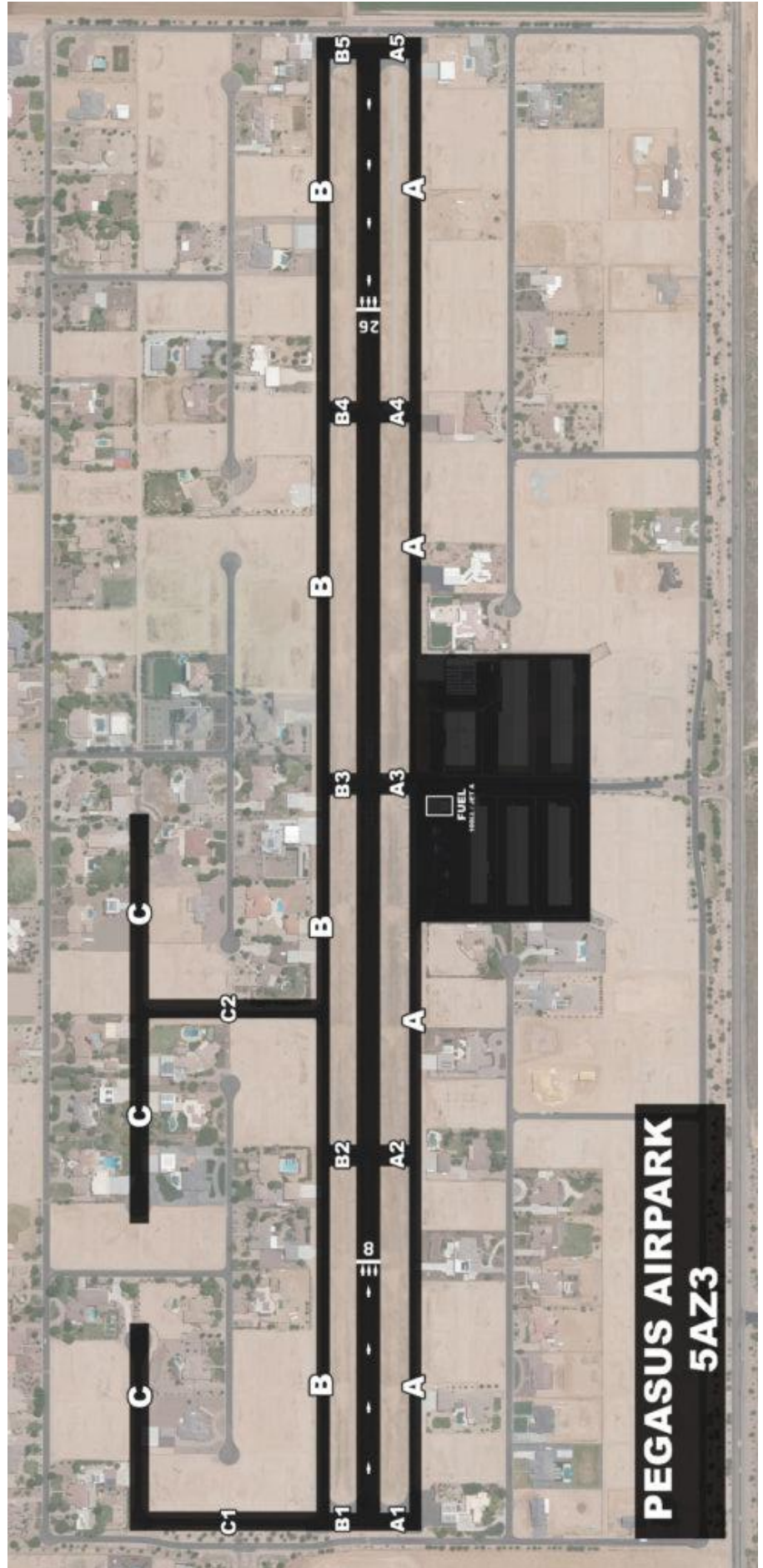


## Taxiway and Intersection Signage at Pegasus

## PLACES TO FLY FOR BREAKFAST:

- The fly in breakfast at Coolidge Municipal Airport (P08) is on the first Saturday of the month.
- On the second Saturday consider flying down to Ryan Field (RYN) near Tucson for breakfast or lunch at Ritchie's Restaurant. They are open from 6 am to 2 pm to serve you. ☒ The Falcon Field Warbirds Squadron fly in breakfast, on the third weekend of the month.
- Grapevine (88AZ) is now open full time, but the third Saturday of each month is a special time for a group camp dinner on Saturday evening. Come and camp for the weekend! The camp host will prepare the main course, and campers, please bring a side dish or dessert to share.
- There is a pancake breakfast on the last Saturday of the month at the Casa Grande Municipal Airport (CGZ). The breakfast is being put on by the Casa Grande Masonic Lodge (Pinal Lodge #30). Time is from 7:00 to 10:00 am, and the breakfast is being served in the air-conditioned terminal. This is planned to be a monthly event until the renovation of the cafe area of the terminal is completed and staffed, which should happen near the end of the year.
